**“XM Radio suspends shock jocks”**

Shock jocks "Opie & Anthony" were suspended for 30 days from their XM Satellite Radio show yesterday after airing a homeless man's crude comments that he wanted to have sex with **Laura Bush**, **Condoleezza Rice**, and **Queen Elizabeth II**. The decision came a week after **Gregg "Opie" Hughes** and **Anthony Cumia** allowed the remarks on air and then apologized for doing so. It appeared last week that XM accepted the ribald duo's apology, but after their show yesterday XM had second thoughts. "Comments made by Opie and Anthony on [Tuesday's] broadcast put into question whether they appreciate the seriousness of the matter," the company said in a statement. "The management of XM Radio decided to suspend Opie and Anthony to make clear that our on-air talent must take seriously the responsibility that creative freedom requires of them." None of this comes as a surprise to **Bruce Mittman**, who first aired the "Opie & Anthony" show on Boston-area WAAF-FM (107.3). "They have a history, and they are much more talented than what they've been doing on the radio lately," Mittman said. "What they did was juvenile." CBS Radio, which simulcasts most of the "Opie & Anthony" show, has not suspended the duo and expects to air the show live this morning, including locally on WBCN-FM (104.1), said CBS spokeswoman **Shannon Jacobs**.
